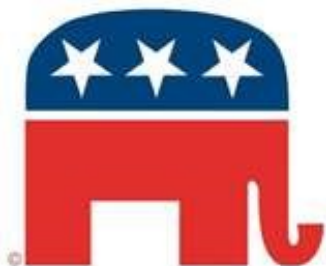

Rasmussen Reports that 80% of GOP likely voters believe Donald Trump will win the Republican Party's presidential nomination. 50% of the polled believed the Trump Nomination to be

“very likely.” It is currently impossible for Kasich to win the nomination outright. Cruz would have to win 86% of the remaining delegates in order to win. Trump needs to win only 54% of the outstanding delegates as he heads into the delegate-rich northeastern states & California.
