Republican State Party Chairman Chris Devaney has resigned to take a job as Executive Director for the

Children's Nutrition Program of Haiti, a charity headquartered in Chattanooga. The State Executive Committee will meet on April 11 in Nashville to elect a new State Party Chairman. Several persons have indicated an interest in that position.

The Senate may be looking at a plan to cover the repairs to cars sustained by some drivers hitting huge potholes which have done extensive damage to the driver's car. One citizen reported having an insurance deductible of \$500, but the pothole damage to his car was \$5,000. At 70 MPH, the large pothole cracked & bent several parts of the car – the struts, the mounting parts, the wheel, the tire, the axle. Depending on where the pothole was, some damages could be filed with the Tenn. Dept. of the Treasury. The state will evaluate & possibly pay claims for damages occurring on a state highway or state road.

District 74 State Rep. Jay Reedy (R-Erin) was appointed Deputy Whip by House Rep. Whip Jeremy Durham (R – Franklin.) "I am honored to be selected to serve the Republican Caucus in this capacity," said Reedy, a former U.S. Army Officer who now is in his first term representing Houston, Humphries, & the western part of Montgomery County.
