

Sen. Ted Cruz suggests that Republicans may block any Supreme Court Nominee by Hillary Clinton should she

win the Presidential Election. There is an historical precedent for fewer Justices. Justice Stephen Breyer recently observed that the current vacancy is not stopping the Supreme Court from doing its job. Nothing in the Constitution forces Congress to eventually confirm a Supreme Court Nominee. The longest vacancy occurred in 1844 when a Supreme Court Seat vacancy went unfilled for 841 days (2.3 years.) More than 8 Supreme Court vacancies took over 1 year to fill. However, no vacancy has gone throughout the entire 4-year term of a President.

Donald Trump took offense at CNN Reporter Dana Bash asking how he defended taking time out from his campaigning in swing states to attend the Grand Opening of his new hotel in Washington, D.C. Trump told Bash he found her question "rude." He also reminded her that he had made 8 campaign stops the previous day and made 3 major speeches. After leaving the hotel Grand Opening after 1 ½ hours, he was going to North Carolina, Florida, prior to New Hampshire. Hillary Clinton took off from her campaign the same day to attend an Adele Concert – with nary a criticism from the major media!

Moms who are illegal immigrants gave birth to 275,000 babies in 2014 – enough to fill a city the size of Orlando according to data from the National Center for Health Statistics. Newborns to illegals accounted for 7% of all births in 2014 according to PEW Research. The current rise in the Birth Rate in the U.S. is driven entirely by immi-
