

NEW REPUBLICAN STATE PARTY CHAIRMAN: The Tennessee Republican State Executive Committee met on April 11 to elect a new GOP Chairman due to the resignation of Chris Devaney after serving for 6 years in that capacity. There were 2 candidates for this office - State Rep. Ryan Hynes & State Rep. Mary Littleton. The winner was Rep. Haynes, a dynamic 30-year-old who has served in the Tennessee House of Representatives since 2008. Ryan, who was only 22 when first-elected, is one of the youngest persons ever elected to be a State Rep-

resentative. Chairman Hayes has served as Chairman of the House State Government Committee where he worked to make state government more efficient & to spur economic development across Tennessee. Chairman Haynes has served on the Caucus Campaign Committee, where he worked tirelessly to elect Republican Legislators. Ryan will resign his legislative seat in November. Rep. Haynes has a degree in Political Science from the University of Tennessee as well as a law degree from the Nashville School of Law. Ryan Haynes is a lifetime member of the NRA, a member of the First Baptist Church of Concord in Knoxville. Chairman Haynes is single.

The Tennessee Supreme Court has postponed execution dates for 4 inmates, halting all scheduled executions while the U.S. Supreme Court decides whether current protocol for using lethal injections are constitutional. Tennessee last executed a prisoner 6 years ago in 2009. Although state will wait on any executions until the legal questions have been settled.

Effective January 1, 2016, it will be illegal to use a cell-phone, "mobile, electronic, or communication device" for conversations, taking photographs or recording video inside a polling place in Tennessee. Cellphone apps that are designed to aid voters inside polling places are allowed. House Democrats criticized the ban for blocking use of mobile electronics devices to record possible voter intimidation of voters & voter fraud. "Selfies" may not be taken while voting nor any pictures be taken of voters in lines within the polling place.

Sen. Bob Corker now has the 67 votes needed to override President Obama's veto on requiring the Congress to have a role in approving Obama's efforts to strike a deal with Iran to halt the regime's development of nuclear weapons. Recent Democratic Senatorial support includes Chuck Schumer (D-NY) & Cory Booker (D-NJ.) Corker's plan would give Congress the power to nix any agreement on the restriction on nuclear power between the U.S. & Iran.
