

the Tennessee Federation of Republican Women. Marie won her office at the TFRW Convention on October 24 in Murfreesboro. Jacob Winter, local Young Republican President, was elected Tennessee State Vice-President at their State Convention. Former Clarksville resident Ashley Elizabeth **Graham** was elected the new Tennessee State Young Republican President.



## Congressman Marsha Blackburn was

next in line to be nominated for Speaker of the House of Representatives in Washington, D.C. if Paul Ryan had declined to run? Rep. Blackburn has been asked to head a new congressional investigation into Planned Parenthood & similar groups who may be profiting from selling aborted "baby parts." John Boehner announced that Blackburn will lead a select group investigating the "grisly practices" that were exposed in an undercover video of Planned Parenthood practices.

Rep. Stephen Fincher tops the fund-raising among Tennessee Congressmen with \$2.7 million cash on hand. Runner-up was Marsha Blackburn with \$2.1 million, followed by Diane Black at \$1.4 million. Congressman John Duncan, Jr. of Knoxville reports having \$1 million. Trailing the congressional pack was Rep. Scott DeJarlais with \$208,000, which is less than his GOP Challenger Grant Stewart with \$693,000. DeJarlais is the only Tennessee Congressman with an announced opponent to date. Democratic Congressman Steve Cohen of Memphis is also reported to have raised \$693,000.

Tennessee Democratic State Party Chairman Mary Mancini has called GOP hopeful Dr. Ben Carson as the "worst of the worst" of the Republican Presidential Candidates. She also called **Jeb Bush** as a former Governor with a "history of failure that is legendary." She charged that Jeb Bush would be "terrible for hardworking Tennesseans." Brent Leatherwood, Tennessee GOP State Executive Director responded, "You know what's terrible for hardworking Americans? A secretary of state who puts our national security at risk by putting classified material on a secret server that can be hacked by Russia, China, or other foreign agents."
