

ABC's "Nashville" didn't get incentive money from the Tennessee Department of Economics & Community Development in the recent budget presented to Gov.

Haslam. However, since the nighttime drama has helped to make Nashville the "it city," there is optimism that "Nashville" will get its supplemental request in the spring. The state offered \$5.5 million in incentives for the current season.

Tennessee is the 6th unhealthiest state in the U.S. according to the America's Health Rankings, compiled by the United Health Foundation. Tennessee ranked 45th in overall health due to the high prevalence of obesity & physical inactivity plus a high violent crime rate. However, Tennessee had the lowest amount of binge drinking of all the states. Tennessee ranked 16th in the ready availability of Primary Care Physicians The healthiest state in the U.S. was Hawaii while the unhealthiest was Mississippi.

Sen. Bob Corker will serve on 4 committees in the new Congress. He will probably be elected to be Chairman of the powerful Senate Foreign Relations Committee. He will serve again on the Senate Banking Committee, Housing & Urban Affairs, & Senate Special Committee on Aging. He is newly-appointed to the Senate Budget Committee.

Sen. Lamar Alexander is expected to chair the Senate Education Committee. He will also serve on the powerful Appropriations Committee, Energy & Natural Resources, & Rules & Administration. Both of our Senators from Tennessee will be heading two vitally important committees in 2015.
