

What a wonderful year it has been for Republicans! For the first time since 1928, the Republican Party holds the Presidency (Electoral College: Trump 306/Clinton 232), the Senate (Reps. 52/Dems. 48), the House (Reps. 239/Dems. 194) & the Governorships (Republicans 33/

Democrats 19.) The GOP now holds majorities in a record 69 of 99 state legislative chambers. We will also get to keep a Conservative Majority in the Supreme Court. It doesn't get much better than that. However, the Democrats still deny that the Republicans have a mandate.
