

Presidential Debates: There are 2 more Presidential Debates in October – October 4 is the Vice-Presidential debate; October 9 is a Town Hall Meeting Format at 8 PM and October 19 is at 8 PM on Fox News Network with Chris Wallace serving as moderator. Be sure to watch.
